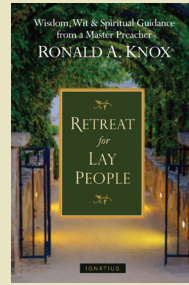

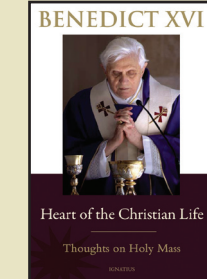
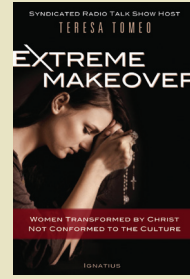
A Retreat for Lay People

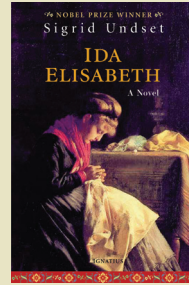

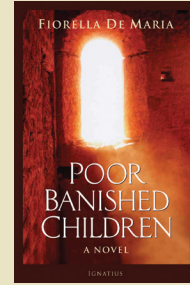

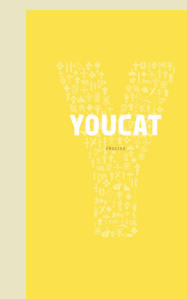
to make an educated guess—that the book and its case are the fruits of a long-lost, but advanced civilization...

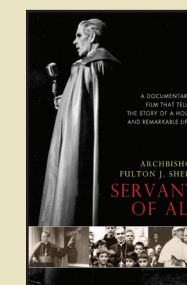

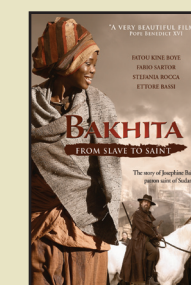
YOUCAT (Youth Catechism of the Catholic Church)
